- Veterans Memorial Park Bronze Plaque: Needs to clean/polish and upgrade granite stone base to upright base (Off Ground Level)
- New Borough Hall Flag Poles: What is the number of flag poles and to ensure that flag poles are in the correction position and height of each one. Especially the flagpole for the US Flag. All the flag poles must meet the requirement in accordance with United State Flag Code Manual for the proper flagpole height and flag size.
