- The Veterans applying must fill out a DMAVA Medal Application (example attached), attach a copy of their DD-214 or discharge papers (WWII vets) to it and either mail, or scan it back to us, at least 30 days prior to the actual date of the Medal Ceremony. This allows them to properly process the application and get Certificates from the Governor and Adjutant General.
- Selecting a designated person could also collect all the applications and either arrange pick-up with us or drop them off.
- Give two (2) dates you would like us to conduct the Medal Ceremony. It must be Monday-Friday, the preferred time would be 11:00am.
- I will also need a confirmed location and the proper address where we will be coming to conduct the Ceremony.
- Need a podium &, PA system with microphone will be needed at the location of ceremony.
- If you want any legislators to be at the event need to let Mr. Robbins' office to know.
- Inform Mr. Robbins of any other Township, County, or State officials you may invite or who will be attending.
- DMAVA will do their best to get you an Officer with a rank of Colonel or higher to be the presenter. (Be aware that this on occasion does not always happen). Lt COL's and CWO's have presented in the past at these events.
